## ANNUAL CURRICULUM PLAN 2025-26

The school curriculum is broadly divided into Junior, Secondary and Senior Secondary sections.

## **Junior School Curriculum (Class III to V)**

At this stage, the children are trained to learn and develop basic concept of the Languages, Environmental Science and Mathematics, besides recognizing the link between different fields of study. Sanskrit, Arts, Music, Dance and Physical Education are a compulsory part of the curriculum.

## Secondary School Curriculum (Class VI to X)

The students prepare for the All India Secondary School Examination conducted by the CBSE.

Besides being taught the Languages, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies, the students also study Information Technology. Emphasis is laid on Yoga, Music, Dance and Physical Education for a holistic development of the girl child. Sanskrit is compulsory upto VIII. They are also given a choice to opt for French as a second language.

## Senior Secondary Level (XI-XII)

The syllabus is in accordance with CBSE guidelines. The school offers Science, Commerce and Arts stream in classes XI and XII. After careful career counselling, aptitude tests and appropriate C.G.P.A in class X various combinations of subjects are offered to students to enable them to pursue a career of their choice later in life. Students are prepared regularly for CBSE exams by concentrating on the prescribed CBSE syllabus, assignment booklets and monitoring programmes. Opportunities are provided at every level to the students for the exercise of their reflective powers, artistic abilities and practical work.

## Scholastic Area : IX & X

No Semester System: Annual examination will take place at the end of the session covering the complete syllabus for classes.

### **1. Scholastic Area :**

- (i) Students will be graded in 8 point grading scale as followed by the board.
- (ii) Annual examination will be conducted of 80 marks and internal assessment 20 marks.
- (iii) Student has to secure 33% marks out of 80 marks in each subject.
- (iv) Internal assessment comprises of Periodic tests (10 Marks), notebook maintenance (5 marks) and subject enrichment activity (5 marks) student need to secure 33% out of overall 20 marks earmarked in each subject.

### Internal Assessment :

- A) Periodic tests will be conducted thrice a year including the portion cumulatively.
- B) I and III Periodic tests will be conducted out of 50 marks and II periodic test will be conducted out of 80 marks. Average of the best two out of 10 will be added in the internal assessment.
- C) Internal assessments will be completed as follows.
- D) Notebook Maintenance can be assessed before the end of each term based on the following parameters. (5 marks)
  - (a) Regularity (b) Assignment Completion (c) Neatness and Upkeep of notebook.
- E) **Subject Enrichment Activities :** will comprise of techniques like (5 Marks) ASL/Reading/Dictation/Debate/Public Speaking etc. for language, Lab activities/Projects/Map work/Model making/Field Trips etc. Which need to be conducted thrice a year.
- F) The assessment of 6th additional subject (class IX and X only) will be assessed as follows  
Theory Examination of 30 marks and practical examination of 70 marks.

## SCHOLASTIC FOR CLASS III TO VIII

- 1. **Scholastic Area :** The assessment structure and Examination for classes III to VIII comprises of two terms i.e. Term-1 and 2 as explained below.
- 2. **Subject Enrichment Activities :** There will be subject specific activities aimed at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students. These activities are to be carried out throughout the term, however they will be evaluated at the term end.
- 3. **Co-Scholastic Activities (Classes III-VIII) :** For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities will be graded term wise on a 3-point grading scale (A = Outstanding B = Very Good and C = Fair). The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork will be the generic criteria for grading in the following co-scholastic activities:
  - (a) Work Education - Work education refers to skill-based activities resulting in goods and services useful to the community.
  - (b) Art Education (Visual and Performing Art)
  - (c) Health and Physical Education (Sports/Martial Arts/Yoga/NCC) etc.
- 4. **Discipline (III to VIII) :** The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading on discipline will be done term wise on a 3 - point grading scale (A = Outstanding B = Very Good and C = Fair)

**Weightage :** In Std. I & II there will be 2 terms. Each term will have one periodic test and one term examination. One term course will not be carried to next term. In Std. III to X in all subjects the previous term course will also be included.

### Promotional Rules :

A student will be promoted to next higher class if he/she fulfills the following criteria:
